WOMAN FAITHFULNESS IN LONE SCHERFIG'S ONE DAY MOVIE (2011): AS A READER RESPONSE STUDY

ABSTRACT

Relationship is the continuity of interaction between two or more people that can easily make the process of recognizing one another. Relationships occur in every process of human life. Relationships can be divided into relationships with peers, parents, family, and the social environment. Most people desire a relationship that consists of two partners who only have eyes for each other. Yet, many people enter relationships with the intention of being faithful and end up straying. Faithfulness requires communication and concentrated effort from both partners. Faithfulness is defined differently across relationships. The aim of this research is to figure out how faithful woman is in a relationship and howthey maintain to be faithful. Based on the analysis of One Day movie (2011) uses reader response theory by Louis Rosenblatt. 1. INTRODUCTION

Transactional Reader-response theory, led by Louise Rosenblatt (1982) and supported by Wolfgang Iser, involves a transaction between the text's inferred meaning and the individual interpretation by the reader influenced by their personal emotions and knowledge. The meaning of the texts appeared to the reader that influenced by various variables a text act as stimulus or stimuli where we respond it by our own way. The feeling, memory, and the association will appear when we read or watching a movie. All of this affect us in understanding and interpret literary work and movie that we have read and watched before, all of our knowledge and even our physical condition and our current mood also affect our understanding and interpretation. Transactional literary theory centers on the reader's contribution in the two-way relationship with the literary text, lifting the reader to a prominent, essential position along with the author and the text. It develops the premise that the reader evokes a literary workthrough selective attention to the details of the author's "paper and ink. "Two types of reading are distinguished: "efferent" reading refers to what the reader "carries away" from the reading event (information, facts, solutions, required actions), while "aesthetic" reading refers to the feelings, attitudes, and ideas aroused in the reader during the actual reading. The degree to which readers use efferent or aesthetic reading activities affects their conception of the literary transaction. As examples from various types of literature show, these elements of transactional literary theory explain how readers evoke a poem, understand the openness or constraints inherent in particular texts, and interpret, appreciate, criticize, and most of all personalize the literary value of the text they read.

3. METHOD

Participant - here the researcher put herself as a main participant to analyze. She will give her knowledge about the movie she watched based on the Rosenblatt theory. She uses transactional reader responses theory as her guidance and give her interpretations that influenced by the personal emotions and knowledge after she watched the movie.

4. FINDINGS AND DISCUSSION

The Actions that Reflected Woman Faithfulness

Faithfulness in general is about how much the level of someone can be stay committed in a personal relationship, friendship or organization which is shown by the attitude and action. It is also shown by giving a constant support through someone or something in a relationship or organization. Woman faithfulness is reflected in One Day Movie (2011). The study by Apostolou and Panayiotou (2019) mentioned the factors why women are more likely to be faithful than men. One of the factors that make women are found more faithful is because they are satisfied with their current relationship. They found that people whose partners treated them well, who didn't want to hurt their partner, or whodidn'twanttorisk destroying their relationship were the most confident that they would not cheat. When women feel satisfied with their current relationship they showed it by some actions. And they actions are explained below:

"I got to know you. You cured me of you. I'd still like to read those poems. What rhymes with Dexter?" (Dexter)

The quotation above shows how faithful Emma was to Dexter, when Dexter continues his life and career in Paris while Emma is in London. She sent many letters to Dexter to show him that she always there for Dexter even when they are miles apart. From all those letters and compilation tapes that have given by Emma, Dexter already knew that Emma keep her feeling to him. She cannot explain her feeling straight forward. So all those letters are the representations of how she feels about Dexter (her partner).

Communication is the main foundation of successful relationship. Two people in relationship should be opened to each other about their thoughts and feelings. In this way, they do not have to be guessing and question about their trust to each other. And there is nothing to be doubt on. This unit discussed about the main character Emma Morley and how she could remain faithful to Dexter Mayhew through the communication they had. In my point of view as a reader and responder, communication is very important in a relationship because everything that happened in a relationship should be discussed. Communication is also important to make people in the relationship build intense connection.

Showing Interest

Have been in a long relationship and friendship, it should not bore somebody to hear stories about their partner. They still have to show that their partner still occupy their mind. At this point Emma is being brave and honest to express her feeling to Dexter after several years hide it. She told Dexter honestly that she hasfallen in love with him since they were in University. She said that she couldn't believe that she almost did sexual intercourse with him, although that plan ended up in failure. She explained honestly that all those epicletters and poem was a representation of her feeling when she couldn't really express it directly and confessed it to Dexter. Emma is so faithfuland dedicated to Dexter and their relationship although he was socomplicated and a total mess. It did not change anything in her feeling and mind. She is still in love with Dexter as she has been doing all this time.

Patience

Patience is the ability to wait calmly for or through something. If it is a virtue, it seems likely that there must be some element of suffering in the waiting, even if the suffering is only boredom and not necessary physical pain.

Patience is something we admire in others, even if we've never told them. It's also something we all wish to have more of especially in relationships with those who matter most. And it's usually those who matter most to us that we tend to be the least patient with. Patience is necessary if we are to see the best in each other. It's needed to keep our relationship meaningful and inspiring. In fact, if one is not making a conscious effort to learn to appreciate their loved one more every day taking time to seriously consider his or her needs, they cannot expect their relationship to grow. More often than not, such a relationship loses the joy and meaning. A valuable and essential connection is lost. And without help, it is avery difficult bond to regain. In one day movie, the main character Emma Morley is shown as a loyal woman to Dexter Mayhew. During their 18 years of their relationship she did so many things tostick up by Dexter although Dexter is a complicated person and always playing around with many women. Her loyalty can be shown by how patience Emma to handle Dexter and the circumstances between both of them.

The Causes of the Main Character Does Faithfulness Deep Love

Too much love indeed make women melt easily and forgive their partner. Even though she has been repeatedly hurt and lied to. Love is also a reason to survive, hoping that the partner can see such great affection from the woman and decide to treat her better. I found this thing in Emma's figure. Emma has a big love for Dexter even Dexter has hurt her and lied to her for uncountable times. She always has reasons to survive and stay with Dexter. She believes that Dexter could change and treat her well, while he always shows that he couldn't change tobe a better person.

Some dialogues of the movie can support this finding, here the dialogues and explanations below:

"I come on, and I say here is funny, you'll like this. There is this guy and he's going out with his girl and he worships her and they buy a flat together. And then he gets her an engagement ring, the lot. But it turns out that she's still in love with her best friend" (Ian)

"Interesting Ian, because I have not seen Dexter for ages" (Emma)

"Do you know how he found out about it? He read it in her poetry." (Ian)

By these dialogues, I can take a conclusion that Emma is really in love with Dexter. It becomes one of the reasons why she can always forgive Dexter and accept everything he did even if it is for the worst thing. Also when she knows how messed and complicated Dexter is.

Long Lasted Relationship

For some women, getting out of a relationship that has existed for a long time is a hard thing to do. There are many considerations such as whether the new personwill be better than the last partner or does the new relationship will be last longlike the previous one, and many more.

Women tend to think that it is better to stay with someone they have known forlong time. Because they know them well instead of starting a new introduction with new people and learn how to adjust themselves to them. On the other hand women choose to be faithful because they feel comfortable and with their partner. Based on this issue, I found the same cases in One Day Movie. Emma Morley is really faithful to Dexter because she has been with him for 18 yearsuntil the end of her life.

Since that time they could not be separated from each other. Comfortable Feeling

The relationship between Emma and Dexter has been going for 18 years and they seem so comfortable to each other. In some scenes of the movie the audience served by the actions and chemistry between those two. Emma seems so excited whenever she met Dexter and also the opposite. They expressed their each other's longing Emma is always become a place to comeback for Dexter whenever he needed somebody to share the stories.

For example from the beginning when Dexter has a problem with his family he called Emma because he knew that Emma is the only person he believes in. And then when he has a problem with his career, his careers were about to end hecame to Emma, and Emma is the only person who can make him feel better afterall the chaotic were happened to him. The last is when he divorced with his wife, after the divorcement he came to Paris to meet Emma. Again Emma becomes his place to escape from the

problem he has in life.

The Impact of Woman Faithfulness

Finally after long wait and storms Emma and Dexter and marry. This is the example that faithfulness from Emma could bring her to the day when she finally could

stay in real long term commitment with Dexter. And they live happily as husband and wife.

Building a Strong Relationship

In One Day movie Emma Morley teaches us how faithful can bring us to some positives impact in a relationship. Her actions and behavior could be the example of woman faithfulness. She has unlimited patience and can hold her pain towards Dexter although actually she felt so hurt. But her patience and faithfulness can make her relationship last long for 18 years until the end of her life.

Being Able to Face Problems in Life

The relationship between Dexter and Emma is very strong, the through all the problems in life together. Dexter is the one who has so much problems and messy life. And Emma is the person who sticks up with him through his problem, this is showing how faithfulness can make two people become stronger to face all the problems in life.

Negative Impacts

Wasting Time

In the movie, Emma Morley sacrifices her 18 years to stand by Dexter although Dexter always brings her down. During 18 years she could not let him go because her feeling to her is too much. The way Emma loves Dexter makes Dexter takes her for granted. Dexter

always thinks that Emma will always be there for him and he could do anything he wanted to. During 18 years of relationship Emma seems to be the person who always sacrifice her time and energy for Dexter, even though Dexter not giving the same in return. In my opinion Emma deserved to be treated better than theway Dexter treat her. But she was blind by her love and how much Dexter meant to her. She wastes her time for the person who cannot treat her as well as she did.

Putting the Feelings Aside

There are many women who love their partners but they sometimes put their feelings aside. They are too focused on the person they love but they do not realize that their feeling could be broke too because of their partner. [&]quot;Yeah, so you're pleased?" (Dexter)

[&]quot;Of course I am pleased Dex, it's a fantastic news really."

Willing to Be Underestimated

Loving somebody is the part of how's life goes for human life, Women sometimes equate loving a man with giving, doing things to please him, and being submissive. Some women seem like they have endless stock of love to give to their partners, but not for themselves. This makes them being underestimated by men because they think no matter what they did to their woman they will not leave them because women love them so much.

I see this thing on Dexter figure in One Day Movie. He seems took Emma for granted because Emma loves him so he could do anything he wanted because he knows that Emma will always accept him no matter what. It could be seen from the way he treated Emma. He treated her so bad, and in return she always treated him so well.
